

## YOUR RIGHTS

Before we ask you any questions, you must understand your rights.

w. V.

You have the right to remain silent.

Anything you say can be used against you in court.

You have the right to talk to a lawyer for advice before we ask you any questions and to have a lawyer with you during questioning.

yes 4V.

If you cannot afford a lawyer, one will be appointed for you before any questioning if you wish.

ya. V.

If you decide to answer questions now without a lawyer present, you will still have the right to stop answering at any time. You also have the right to stop answering at any time until you talk to a lawyer.

## WAIVER OF RIGHTS

I have read the above statement of my rights and have also had my rights explained to me by a law enforcement officer. I understand these rights. Knowing these rights, I do not want a lawyer at this time. I waive these rights knowingly and willingly agree to answer questions and/or make a statement.
