4. Narrative: I SPOKE WITH RUEBEN BLAKLEY AGAIN TODAY 12NOV95 AT 1340 HRS. RUEBEN SAID THAT HE HAD THOUGHT OF A FEW OTHER THINGS THAT TED HAD TOLD HIM AND THAT HE WANTED ME TO KNOW. ONE WAS THAT JUST BEFORE PATRICIA DIED THAT TED SHOWED HIM A DELTA MITER SAW AND TOLD HIM THAT SOMEONE CAME BY LYLES AND SOLD IT TO HIM FOR \$50.00 AND THAT IT WAS PRACTLY NEW. HE ALSO SAID THAT TED BOUGHT MODEL AIRPLANES AND KEPT THEM HID FROM PATRICIA BECAUSE HE WAS PAYING FIVE AND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR THEM AND PATRICIA WAS KEEPING THE BOOKS FOR THE BUSINESS AND DID NOT KNOW WHERE THE MONEY HAD WENT. RUEBEN SAID THAT PATRICIA HAD TOLD HIM THIS AND SHE ALSO TOLD HIM THAT TED WOULD USE COMPANY MONEY TO BUY PERSONEL ITEMS WITH AND NOT TELL HER AND THE BOOKS WOULD NOT BALANCE. SHE TOLD RUEBEN THAT TED TOLD HER THAT HE COULD RUN THE BUSINESS BETTER THAT SHE COULD AND THAT HE WAS RUNNING IT BEFORE THEY WERE MARRIED AND KNEW HOW TO RUN IT AND WOULD NOT LET HER KEEP THE BOOKS ANYMORE.~~ (C)
RUEBEN FURTHER STATED THAT TED HAD TOLD HIM ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS THAT SOMEONE HAD COME BY AND SOLD HIM GOOD ITEMS VERY CHEAP AND IN RUEBENS THINKING, TO CHEAP, OR CHEAP ENOUGH TO MAKE SOMEONE THINK THEY WERE STOLEN.
