The State acknowledges its continuing duty to disclose any discoverable or exculpatory materials which come to the attention of the State.

Additionally, discovery of any items presently held as evidence by the Guilford County Sheriff's Department can be obtained by contacting and arranging for an opportunity to inspect the items. Items of physical evidence can be inspected pursuant to reasonable safeguards and only if the Defendant waives the chain of custody from the point the Defendant's counsel inspects the evidence to the introduction of the evidence at trial. Please prepare and present a suitable waiver to the District Attorney's Office for the 18th Judicial District or the Guilford County Sheriff's Department.
