MR. ALVIS FUEL STATED THAT HE HAS KNOWN TED KIMBLE SINCE HE WORKED AT DAVE BUTTLER'S PAWN SHOP ON HIGH POINT ROAD. HE SAID THAT HE'S BEEN THERE SINCE 1987 OR SO. MR. FUEL STATED THAT HE HAD NOT BOUGHT ANY ITEMS FROM TED OR HIS WIFE, WHICH MEANT THAT THEY HAD PAWNED SOMETHING. HE STATED THAT TED BOUGHT TOOLS AND OTHER ITEMS AND WHEN HE GOT MARRIED ROUGHT HIS WIFE IN AND INTRODUCED HER TO HIM AND SHE BEGAN TO BUY I'L .3. AFTER THE MARRIAGE THEY BOUGHT EACH OTHER ITEMS FROM JEWELRY TO TOOLS.
