AT THE TIME OF ARRIVAL AT BRANDON STATION COURT THE WITNESS VEHICLE CAME TO A COMPLETE STOP IN ORDER FOR THE VEHICLE IN FRONT OF THEM TO MAKE THEIR TURN INTO BRANDON STATION COURT. AT THE SAME TIME A VEHICLE APPROACHING FROM THE OTHER DIRECTION HAD ALSO COME TO A COMPLETE STOP AND HAD THEIR TURN SIGNAL ON TO TURN LEFT. WITNESS OBSERVED ONE WHITE MALE IN THE VEHICLE. WITNESS LOOKED AT THE WHITE MALE AND CONTINUED TO LOOK AT HIM AS THEY AGAIN BEGAN TO MOVE ON DOWN HIGHWAY 22. WITNESS STATED THAT THEY GOT A GOOD LOOK AT THE PERSON. WITNESS FURTHER STATED THAT THEY LOOK IN THE REARVIEW MIRROR AND SAW THE VEHICLE, WHICH THEY DESCRIBED AS A BLUE CHEVROLET CAMARO, TURN LEFT INTO BRANDON STATION COURT. WITNESS STATED THAT THEY DID NOT KNOW THE PERSON DRIVING THE BLUE CAMARO AND HAD NOT SEEN THEM BEFORE OR AFTER THAT OCCASION. WITNESS SAID THAT THEY DROVE ON TO THEIR HOME IN RANDOLPH COUNTY AFTER SEEING THE WHITE MALE IN THE BLUE CAMARO. WITNESS FURTHER STATED THAT THEY REMEMBERED WHAT THE PERSON LOOKED LIKE AND THOUGHT THEY COULD PICK THE PERSON OUT OF IF SHOWN SOME PICTURES.

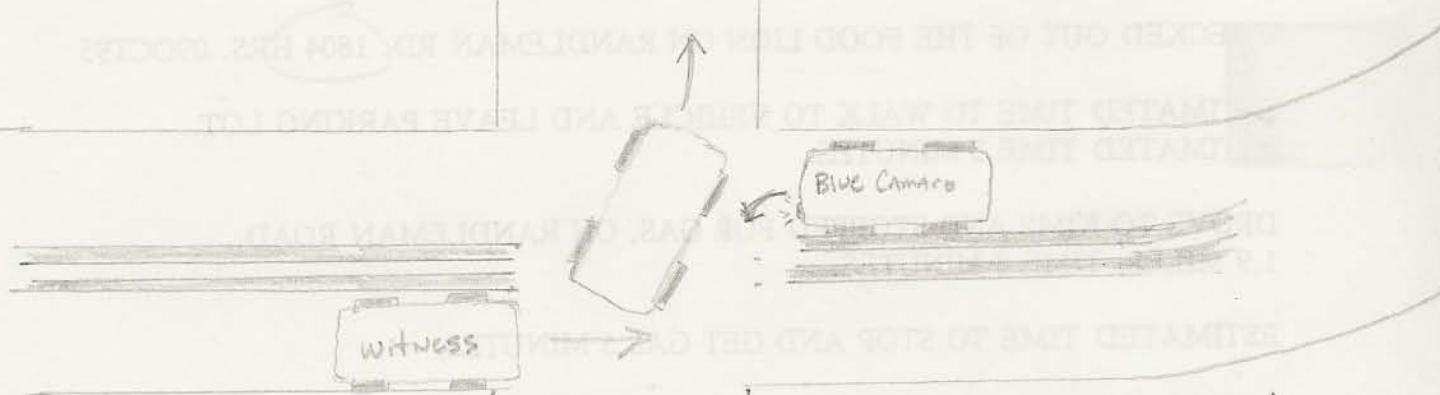

NOTE: THE TIMES LISTED ABOVE ARE ESTIMATED BY ACTUAL DRIVING TIME AND RECORDING THE DISTANCE BETWEEN EACH STOP. THE ACTUAL TIME COULD BE THREE TO FOUR MINUTES MORE MAKING THE ARRIVAL TIME AT BRANDON STATION COURT 1825 HRS., DUE TO THE FACT THAT IT COULD HAVE TAKEN LONGER TO GET TO THE VEHICLE AT FOOD LION AND MORE THAT FIVE MINUTES SPENT AT THE GAS STOP. MY TIMES WERE RECORDED DURING DAYTIME HOURS, NORMAL TRAFFIC AND AT THE POSTED SPEED.

THE FOLLOWING ARE TIMES RECORDED AS A RESULT OF STATEMENTS MADE TO DETECTIVE CHURCH BY MR AND MRS STUMP IN AN INTERVIEW AT THEIR RESIDENCE ON 10JUNE96.

MR STUMP GOT OFF WORK AT 1630 HRS.

MR STUMP ARRIVED AT KIM AND RONNIES MOBILE HOME AT 1650 HRS.

MR STUMP LEFT KIM AND RONNIES AND DROVE HOME AT 1730 HRS.

MRS STUMP STATED THAT KIM AND RONNIE ARRIVED AT HER HOME JUST AFTER THE NEWS HAD COME ON 1802-1804.

MRS STUMP STATED THAT KIM AND RONNIE ONLY STAYED A FEW MINUTES AND LEFT GOING TO THE WINN DIXIE, 1813 HRS.

NOTE: MRS STUMPS STATEMENT TO DET. CHURCH DID NOT GIVE SPECIFIC TIMES. THE TIMES LISTED ABOVE ARE ESTIMATED ACCORDING TO THE STATEMENT SHE GAVE.

DRIVING TIME UNDER NORMAL CONDITIONS AND WITHIN THE SPEED LIMIT, TEN MINUTES.

ALLOWING TWO MINUTES TO STOP AT RONNIE AND KIMS TRAILER WOULD MAKE THE TOTAL TIME OF TWELVE MINUTES.

Redacted Witness statement, June 27, 1996.  
victim's name: Patricia Gail Kimble

The witness stated that on May 9, 1995, the witness withdrew some money from the teller machine and then drove over to the Food Lion where bought a few groceries. Left store , then drove down Randleman Road and stopped at store and bought gas. Left and went toward the stop sign at Pleasant Garden Road. While stopped at the stop sign, a beige Volvo 4-door got in front of witness. When the witness got to Pleasant Garden the Volvo turned left on Neeley road and the witness followed and also followed the Volvo onto Appomatox road that leads into highway 22 at Alliance Church road. As the witness approached Hagen Stone park road the Volvo pulled away and got a good ways ahead of the witness. When the witness rounded the curve and approached Bandon Station Court the Volvo had slowed down again and come to an abrupt stop and turned quickly into Brandon Station Ct. The witness had to come to a complete stop when the Volvo turned in. The witness said when the Volvo had slowed and turned in a second vehicle, a Chevrolet Camero, blue or black in color, the witness was not completely sure of the exact color but did know for sure that it was a dark color camero, was traveling towards Pleasant Garden meeting them and had stopped with his turn signal on waiting to turn into Brandon Station Ct. As the witness accelerated past the Chevrolet Camero, the witness was able to get a good look at the driver and this incident has stayed with the witness until this day, when the witness was able to pick Ronnie Kimble out of two photo lineups as being the person who was driving the Camero.
