4. Narrative: AT APPROXIMATELY 0810 HRS. KAREN SCARBARO WHO WORKS FOR THE SHERIFF'S DEPT. CALLED ME AT MY DESK AND SAID THAT TED KIMBLE WAS HERE TO SEE ME. I CALLED THE EVIDENCE SECTION AND ADVISED OFFICER MCDANIEL TO GET ITEMS 49,51,52 AND 53 READY THAT TED KIMBLE AND MYSELF WOULD BE OVER SHORTLY TO PICK SAME UP THAT I WAS RELEASING SAME TO TED. - (A)

I WENT OUT AND GREETED TED AND WE WALKED OVER TO GREENE STREET TO OUR EVIDENCE SECTION. OFFICER MCDANIEL HAD THE ITEMS READY AND I SIGNED THE RELEASE AND TED SIGNED AS PICKING SAME UP. TED TOOK POSSESSION OF THE ITEMS AND WE WALKED BACK OVER TO SYCAMORE STREET. WHILE IN THE EVIDENCE ROOM TED ASKED ME IF WHEN HE COULD GET THE PURSE AND THE CREDIT CARDS AND I TOLD HIM THAT I COULD NOT RELEASE ANYTHING ELSE WITHOUT THE DISTRICT ATTORNEYS PERMISSION. I TOLD HIM THAT THE PURSE BELONGED TO PATRICIA AND THAT HE PROBABLY WOULD NOT GET IT UNTIL THE CASE WAS OVER AND THAT THE CREDIT CARDS COULD PROBABLY BE RELEASED BUT ONLY AFTER THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY SAID SO. I FURTHER TOLD HIM THAT WE NEEDED TO SIT DOWN AROUND THE TABLE AND DISCUSS THE MATTER AND HE NODDED HIS HEAD. I FURTHER TOLD HIM THAT HIS ATTORNEY SHOULD HAVE GIVEN HIM A COPY OF THE LIST OF ITEMS THAT I WAS RELEASING TO HIM TODAY THAT SGT. DeBERRY HAD GIVEN HIM A COPY JUST LIKE I WAS SHOWING HIM DESCRIBING WHAT WAS TO BE RELEASED AT THIS TIME. HE SAID HIS ATTORNEY HAD TOLD HIM THAT HE ONLY HAD A ROUGH DRAFT OF WHAT WAS GOING TO BE RELEASED AND AGAIN I TOLD HIM THAT HE SHOULD HAVE BEEN GIVEN A COPY SO HE WOULD HAVE KNOW WHAT HE WAS GOING TO GET AT THIS TIME. - (B) - (C) - (D)

WHEN WE GOT TO THE SHERIFF'S DEPT, OUTSIDE THE BUILDING, TED ASKED IF HE WOULD BE ABLE TO GET PATRICIAS PAGER AND THAT HE HAD BOUGHT SAME AND GIVEN IT TO HER. I TOLD HIM THAT I REALLY DIDN'T SEE A PROBLEM AT THIS TIME WITH RELEASING THE PAGER BUT THAT THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY WOULD HAVE TO APPROVE THE RELEASE OF THE PAGER.

I TOLD TED THAT I WOULD CONTACT THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY AND THAT I WOULD LET HIM KNOW. - (E)

TED LEFT DRIVING A BLACK NEW MODEL CHEVROLET CAMERO. - (F)

5. Reporting Officer/Assignment: DET. J.D. CHURCH
