

I don't want to cause trouble so I'm asking instead of doing as I please. Others wear shower shoes and everything else. It's not fair to press me when I've got a medical need. I'll wear the flat orange shoes to visit so it will look good up front. What's really dumb is I'll be coming off lock-up soon and it's going to cost the state hundreds to provide shoes only needed at WCI.
